#### NO LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATION PACKETS WILL BE ACCEPTED!

- 1. <u>Eligibility and Criteria</u>: BPA member in good standing, a graduating high school senior (2019 2020), enrollment in a post-secondary institution by **October 1, 2020**, leadership qualities, academic record, two recommendations, essay responses, BPA chapter involvement, and completed package.
- 2. The three (3) \$500.00 scholarship and three (3) \$250 scholarship finalist recipients will be determined by the Selection/Interview Panel on Friday, **January 10, 2020** at the BPA Regional Conference. This panel is selected by the Area II Region 3 BPA Scholarship Committee. The Selection/Interview Panel will screen applications, check references and make a selection of finalists to interview on Friday, **January 10, 2020**. Interview finalists will be notified by the Regional Advisor.
- 3. Applicant must submit a brief <u>typed essay</u> (200 words or 1 page maximum) describing how being a member of BPA impacted his/her life. Included in the essay should be a description of a situation(s) or event(s) demonstrating initiative and willingness to go above and beyond.
- 4. Selected finalists must participate in a brief interview with the scholarship interview/selection panel during BPA Regional Competition to be held in Weslaco, Texas on **Friday**, **January 10**, **2020**.
- 5. Applicant must submit two (2) **recommendations** using the forms provided with the application.
- 6. Applicant must submit the original application packet (including support material and recommendations) postmarked by **November 21**, **2019** to:

7. Award notification will be announced at BPA Regional Competition Awards Ceremony on Friday, **January 10, 2020**. Recipient must attend a post-secondary institution by **October 1, 2020**.
